Justification Series Tip #2

Two weeks ago we touched on justification with the tip titled *Pressure, Pressure, Pressure*. In that tip approximately one million dollars in lost production and maintenance costs were prevented through the motor reliability program. Now that's justification! However, the million dollar saves are not the norm in reliability. More often it's the many smaller saves that are easily overlooked, but when added up amount to plenty of justification through cost avoidance. It is critical that you develop a process to quantify the saves you have accomplished no matter how small. Once you have your program up and running you should consider shedding light on your successes through local or regional reliability chapters like the Society of Maintenance and Reliability Professionals (SMRP). A brief presentation will not only get your program well deserved recognition, it can also give you points towards re-certification as a Certified Maintenance and Reliability Professional within the SMRP organization.
