Gaps in Your Electric Motor Reliability Program

We have all heard the idiom "the best laid plans..." meaning that even the best plans can result in failure. All plans have gaps that can be filled, modified, or at least be made aware of. A common gap we find in electric motor reliability is the ineffective balance between collecting data and analyzing the data. If you feel that your collecting lots of data but are still missing a few faults you may be a victim of the data rut. Day in day out doing your job collecting reliability data to the point where there is no time for the critical analysis of data to identify anomalies and trends.
