## Maintain to Maintain

Protecting investments can be more important to some than to others. Just as facilities protect assets by maintaining them, the tools used to maintain the assets must also be maintained. Test equipment manufacturers usually suggest calibrating equipment once per year and updating software and features as available. Maintenance agreements and/or extended warranty packages usually include these benefits and more. Uncalibrated equipment can cause erroneous data trending, incorrect analysis, and loss of data integrity. This ultimately ends in wasted dollars for the facility. Maintain your tools, so they can maintain your assets.
