For each spare motor presently being stored in your warehouse, a good resolution would be to rotate the shaft and inspect the electrical health of each motor before the end of the year. A warehouse can be an environment detrimental to the health of the motor bearings and insulation. Let's make sure, before we spend countless hours installing a spare motor, that we are not going to experience an electrical or mechanical failure shortly after start-up. Ten minutes now may save you ten hours in the future.
