## Templates to the Rescue?

If you cry out in frustration every time a standard changes because of the extra workload caused by modifying your caution and alarm set points, never fear, templates are here! Although not new, many of our users have overlooked the very powerful ability to establish alarm templates around a specific make, model, or motor application. Simply build the template of alarm set points for your specific motor type, give it a name, then all at once select the appropriate motors and assign them to the new alarm template with one push of a button. When you decide to change any of the alarms due to a standard change or based on your own experience and historical data, just change it once in the template and all of the assigned motors are immediately brought up to date with the new set points.
